



Note:

- (i) For reimbursement of covered storage charges, the State Government is required to furnish a certificate to the SRM of FCI that the stocks were kept in the covered godowns.
- (ii) Payment of statutory charges will be subject to furnishing of necessary notification by the State Govt.
- (iii) *The above cost is for use of new gunny bags. In case the actual cost of gunnies is lower, the same actual would be applicable.
- (iv) The above cost/incidentals are provisional. The State Govt. should sent its claim for final incidentals reconciled with annual accounts alongwith accounts audited by the auditors appointed by the Comptroller & Auditor General & documentary proof & detailed justification for each item at the earliest after the end of the season.
- (v) This issue with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vides their Dy. No. /FA/2015 dated.
- (vi) The transportation charges at distribution stage is being allowed only for transportation of coarsegrain upto the designated depots. Payment of transportation charges for transportation of coarsegrain from designated depots to FPS will be regulated as per gazette notification dated 17.08.2015 regarding Central Assistance to States/UTs for meeting the expenditure on intra-State movement and handling of food grains and FPS dealers margin under Section 22(4)(d) of the NFSA Act, 2013. It is also clarified that designated depots means depots to be specified from time to time by Govt. of India for the purpose of distribution of foodgrains under NFSA. While submitting its claim for sanction of advance/provisional/ final subsidy state Govt. should certify that transportation charges for transportation of coarsegrain from designated depot to FPS are not claimed under food subsidy as same is being separately claimed under Central Assistance for NFSA
