**Sub: Conversion of issue prices of balance quantity of wheat and rice out of flood allocation made to Govt. of J&K on 12.02.2015 at MSP/MSP derived prices to APL rates-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to say that Govt. of India has approved allocation of the balance quantity of 292 tons of wheat and 46944 tons of rice out of the additional allocation of foodgrains made to Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir for flood relief vide this Department's letter of even number dated 12.02.2015, at APL rates instead of MSP/MSP derived prices. The validity period for lifting of these stocks has already been extended upto 30.09.2015 earlier vide this Department's letter of even number dated 10.06.2015.

2. Govt. of J&K is requested to ensure that the balance quantity of foodgrains against the flood allocation is lifted within the expended validity period upto 30.09.2015 and actually distributed to the affected people and a Utilization Certificate of the flood allocation is also furnished to this Department.
