Subject: Additional monthly allocation of foodgrains to the States/UTs for BPL families under TPDS for October and November, 2015 or till implementation of NFSA, whichever is earlier.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Government of India has enacted National Food Security Act, under which foodgrains are allocated to the States/UTs at highly subsidized prices based on 2011 population census. As some of the State/UT Governments had not completed the identification of eligible beneficiaries under NFSA and other pre-requisites for implementation of the Act, Government of India allowed the States/UTs to complete the prescribed requisite measures under NFSA and implement the Act upto 30.9.2015. However, many States/UTs have not yet implemented the Act so far which is a matter of concern. The matter has been considered and as an exceptional and special measure, it has been decided to make the following additional monthly allocation of foodgrains to the non-NFSA States/UTs for the BPL families at BPL rates for two months i.e. October and November 2015 or till implementation of the NFSA by the States/UTs, whichever is earlier:
