Sub: Allotment of additional foodgrains to Jammu & Kashmir for flood affected families- reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 04.10.2014 addressed to GM, FCI, J&K regarding additional allotment of foodgrains to the State of J&K for flood relief and to say that the request of Govt. of J&K has been considered and the following decisions have been taken in this regard:

- 1) Additional allotment of 199215 tons of rice and 10137 tons of wheat to J&K at MSP/MSP derived prices respectively for flood relief.
 - 2) Regularization of 9178 tons of rice lifted by J&K Govt. during September-October, 2014 for flood relief as additional allotment at MSP derived price.
 - 3) Removal of waiver given to J&K Govt. for lifting of foodgrains on pre-payment basis.
2. The validity period for lifting of additional allotment of foodgrains at (1) above will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.
