I am directed to refer to your letter No.PDS.II(1)/1713/2014 dated 18.06.2014 on the above subject and to say that consequent upon enforcement of the AP State Reorganization Act, 2014 and formation of two separate States Andhra Pradesh and Telangana based on population ratio 58.32 : 41.68 respectively out of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh State w.e.f. 02.06.2014 and in modification of this Department's allocation letter No.1-1/2014-BP.III (1) dated 17.02.2014, it has been decided to make following monthly TPDS allocation of foodgrains to your State for AAY, BPL and APL families from July, 2014 onwards till the implementation of NFSA:

2. The Validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of revised allocation for the month of July will be 50 days from the date of issue of this letter. The validity period for the allocation for the rest of the months will be as per the existing instructions. If any quantity of rice and wheat has already been lifted in excess of the above revised allocation, the same may be adjusted against the allocation under the respective category for the subsequent month(s). Other terms and conditions mentioned in this Department's allocation letter dated 17.02.2014 remain unchanged.
