Sub: Additional monthly allocation of foodgrains to the States/UTs for additional BPL families under TPDS from April to September, 2015 or till implementation of NFSA-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to say that under National Food Security Act (NFSA), foodgrains are allocated at highly subsidized Central Issue Prices (CIPs) as per 2011 population estimates. As the State/UT Governments mentioned below have not so far implemented NFSA, Govt. of India has allowed them to complete the necessary formalities so as to implement the NFSA by 30th September, 2015. As an exceptional measure, Government of India has decided to allot additional monthly foodgrains to the States/UTs as mentioned below at BPL rates for distribution to additional BPL families during April to September, 2015 or till implementation of NFSA in the State/UT, whichever is earlier:

2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above additional allotment for the months of April and May, 2015 will be upto 30.4.2015 and 10.5.2015 respectively. The validity period for rest of the months will be as in the case of normal monthly TPDS allocation i.e. allocation for the month of June, 2015 will be lifted upto 31.5.2015 and so on.

3. As the above additional allocation has been made to the States/UTs as an exceptional measure upto September, 2015 or till implementation of NFSA, whichever is earlier, **under no circumstances, this additional BPL allotment at BPL rates will be made beyond September, 2015.**
