Sub: Revised allocation of foodgrains to Madhya Pradesh under NFSA from July, 2014 onwards – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letters No. 7-16/2014/29-1 dated 13.06.2014 and No.1619/NFSA/2014 dated 23.06.2014 on the above subject and to say that the request of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh for revised allocation under NFSA on account of increase in number of total Priority Household beneficiaries has been considered and it has been decided to revise the allocation of foodgrains to the State w.e.f. July, 2014. Accordingly, in partial modification of this Department's allocation letter No.2/Madhya Pradesh/2014-BP.III dated 25.06.2014, the monthly allocation of foodgrains to Madhya Pradesh under NFSA from July, 2014 onwards will be 14500 tons of maize, 184597 tons of wheat and 66366 tons of rice at Central Issue Price of Re.1/-, 2/- and 3/- per kg respectively.

2. The validity period for deposit of the cost and lifting of the revised allocation of July, 2014 will be 50 days from the date of issue of this letter. The other terms and conditions mentioned in the allocation letter of even number dated 28.02.2014 remain unchanged.
