

This allocation will cease to continue with immediate effect on implementation of National Food Security Act (NFSA) in the State.

2. This additional rice will be lifted in eight equal monthly instalments for distribution during August, 2014 to March, 2015. The allocation for distribution in the month of August should be lifted by 31.07.2014 positively. Similarly for distribution in subsequent months it should be lifted by the end of the previous month.
