**Sub: Additional Allocation of 30,000 MT of rice to Tamil Nadu at MSP derived price in context of extensive devastation due to unprecedented floods.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter, No. nil dated 17.12.2015, of the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, and the D.O. letter, No. 4391/B1/2015 dated 04.01.2016, of the Chief Secretary of Tamil Nadu on the above subject and to say that the request of Tamil Nadu Government for additional allocation of 30,000 MT of rice has been considered. It has been decided to allocate 30,000 MT of rice at MSP derived price to enable the Tamil Nadu Government to meet the requirement of flood relief.

2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above allocated foodgrains will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter. The State Govt. is requested to ensure that the above additional allocation of foodgrains is lifted within the validity period and a Utilization Certificate in this regard may also be furnished to this department.
