Applications are invited from the eligible officers for filling up one vacant post of **Assistant Professor (Physical Chemistry)**, a General Central Service, Group 'A' Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post in Level-11 of the Pay Matrix (PB-3: Rs. 15,600-39,100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6,600/-, as per 6th CPC) at National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, a sub-ordinate office in the Department of Food & Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, by Composite method: Promotion/ Deputation (including short-term contract).
